JSML only tolerate 20% of similarity index for all submitted article. If possible, similarity check could be provided along with submitted article.

Subtopic [Small Letters, Bold, Font Size 12 and Justified]

Results and discussion should be clear and concise. Please avoid extensive citations and discussion of published literature. Please ensure the figures and the tables included in the single file are placed next to the relevant text in the manuscript.

Each tables (refer with: Table 1, Table 2, ...) should be presented as part of the text. A descriptive title should be placed above each table.




Figure 1. Figure text and caption [Centered, times new roman, font size 10, included in body text]

Each figures (refer with: Figure 1, Figure 2, ...) also should be presented as part of the text. The caption should be self-contained and placed centred below the figure. Capitalize only the first word of each Figure caption and Table title and bold them.

Equations (refer with: Eq. 1, Eq. 2, ...) and there should be one line of space above the equation and one line of space below it before the text continues. The equations have to be numbered sequentially, and the number put in parentheses at the right hand edge of the text.

Micrographs, etc. must include a scale bar.
